FORMAT

The Caribbean Golf Classic is an Individual and Team event competed for by teams of unlimited number of players from each participating country, playing eighteen holes each day Modified Stableford competition. The men's teams will compete for the **Robert Grell Trophy** and the ladies for the **Jodi Munn Barrow Trophy**. The Team (country) with the most points wins the **George Noon Cup**.

The Modified Stableford points awarded are on a gross basis are as follows:

- 2 over par - 1 point
- 1 over par - 2 points
- Par - 3 points
- 1 under par - 4 points
- 2 under par - 5 points
- 3 under par - 6 points

The range of handicap in each flight is 5 strokes up to 7 flights in each competition. Within each flight all competitors compete equally and no handicap allowance is given. Individual prizes will be awarded in each flight. The flights are:

- 1st Flight – 0-5.0 HI
- 2nd Flight – 5.1-10.0 HI
- 3rd Flight – 10.1-15.0 HI
- 4th Flight – 15.1-20.0 HI
- 5th Flight – 20.1-25.0 HI
- 6th Flight – 25.1-30.0 HI
- 7th Flight – 30.1+ HI
